## I Will Build My Church

Christ's Church is built on the **Rock of Revelation** (Matthew 16:19).

Jesus Christ is the chief cornerstone (1 Peter 2:4–6). Ministry of the Church consists of the Melchisedec priesthood—Prophet, Apostle, Evangelist, (Ephesians 4:11), Elder (Acts 14:23), Seventy (Luke 10:1–2), High Priest (hebrews 8:3), Bishop (1 Timothy 3:1–4); and the Aaronic priesthood—Priest (Hebrews 7:11), Teacher (ephesians 4:11), and Deacon (Philippians 1:1).

Enter the Church by **Faith** (Hebrews 11:6), **Repentance** (Mark 1:13), and **Baptism by Water** and the **Spirit** (John 3:5). **Walk the Narrow Way** (Matthew 7:23).

Receive the Laying on of Hands for Blessing of Children (Mark 10:12–14), Administration for Healing of the

Sick (James 5:14–16), Ordination (Acts 13:2–3), and Confirmation (Acts 8:14–17). Believe in the Resurrection of the Dead (John 11:25) and Eternal Judgment (Matthew 25:31–47).

**Stewardship** is God's call (1 Peter 4:10; Matthew 25:14–31).

Love for God and other people are the greatest commandments (Mark 12:33–36). Spiritual power is demonstrated through the gifts of the Spirit: Dreams and Visions (Acts 2:17); and Wisdom, Knowledge, Faith, Healing, Miracles, Prophecy, Discerning of Spirits, diverse kinds of Tongues, and the Interpretation of Tongues (1 Corinthians 12:1–11).

## The Gospel Ladder
