REUNION RULES

**By registering for reunion, you are agreeing to these rules.
Please read carefully.**

1. Registration is required by all people entering reunion grounds, even if not spending the night. Please return your registration by July 7, 2023.
2. When arriving at reunion, check-in with Renee Webster at the Central Lodge main room.
3. ALL persons under the age of 18, must be accompanied by either a parent or an adult sponsor. Minors are the responsibility of their parent or adult sponsor. Minors will only be supervised by another adult during morning classes.
4. **NO PETS ARE ALLOWED ON THE REUNION GROUNDS. Please make other arrangements for your pets.** (The ONLY exception to this rule is service animals, which are allowed according to federal laws.)
5. Please limit the use of electronic devices (radio, TV, ipad, cell phone, etc.). Remember, we are here to draw apart from the world for worship and fellowship.
6. Please bring your scriptures: Bible, Book of Mormon, and Doctrine and Covenants. There will be many opportunities to use them.
7. If you play an instrument, please bring it. If you are interested in sharing in ministry of music (instrumental or vocal) during a service, please contact Mickey Dippel at (304) 282-4849. There may also be an opportunity for a talent show during the week.
8. Clothing should be informal and modest. Please no short shorts, inappropriate swim wear, foul language, nor drug culture. Priesthood should come prepared to share and fulfill the responsibilities of their calling. Priesthood, please bring clothing needed for leading and/or assisting during services.

Housing Options

A Camping Committee has been established to attend to the needs of Reunion. This Committee has decided that preference of housing will first be offered to people living in our region. This includes people living in Ohio, Pennsylvania, West Virginia, and Virginia. While we encourage all to attend, our camp has grown to the size that we do not have accommodations for everyone who desires to stay in the Central Lodge. Housing placements will be made on a "first-come, first-served" basis, giving preference to those within our region until May 1, 2023. If you wish to be considered for preferential placement, your registration must be received before May 1, 2023. **On May 1, 2023, registration will be open to everyone.** Housing placements will still be made on a "first-come, first-served" basis; however, your geographical location will no longer be considered. Every effort will be made to give you your choice of housing.

Please be aware that both lodges are designed for people to share rooms. It puts a strain on the reunion to put a single person in any room. If you are registering as a single person, please list on the next page people you are willing to share a room with.

Prices listed are what we are charged as a Reunion and are all inclusive of room and meals. Free-will donations are taken during the evening services at Reunion to cover expenses. At reunion, check may be made out to, "KARRA." Please do NOT send money with your registration.

- Central Lodge:** 13 rooms, each with private bathroom, 3 of which are handicap accessible. There is one additional room that has no bathroom. \$60.00 per person, per night.
- West Lodge:** 12 rooms, each sleeping between 6 and 10 people in bunk beds. Rooms do not have individual bathrooms, rather there are common bathrooms (separate for men and women) located in the center of the lodge. \$44.10 per person, per night.
- Cabin:** 10 cabins are available, each sleeping up to 12 people in bunk beds. Cabins do not have individual bathroom, rather there is a bath house located among the cabins. \$42.30 per person, per night.
- Trailer/RV:** electric, water, and sewer hook-ups are provided. No bathrooms provided, however, you are welcome to use any bathroom/shower on reunion grounds. \$42.30 per person, per night.
- Tent:** electrical hook-ups provided. Bathhouse nearby. \$34.50 per person, per night.
- Day Camper:** responsible for own lodging off of camp grounds. Enjoy all facilities while on grounds. \$10.80 per person, per meal.
